

# Table. Factors Predicting Wearing-Off in Parkinson's Disease

Variable	P-value
Younger age at onset of PD	$P < .001$
Higher baseline UPDRS Part II score	$P < .001$
North American vs European	$P < .001$
Female	$P = .003$
Higher baseline UPDRS Part III score	$P = .046$

- Prospective, double-blind study of 745 levodopa-naïve patients with Parkinson's disease
- Patients divided into 4 groups based on nominal levodopa dose:
  - <400mg/day (n=180)
  - 400mg/day (n=325)
  - >400-600mg/day (n=189)
  - >600mg/day (n=51)
